Colours:

International colours -

Awarded to a student who is part of UCSU sports club and selected for BUCS National Squad or represented their sport at an international level during their study at University of Chichester.

Full Colours -

Awarded to sport and society members who have represented the university and shown dedication and distinct performance. This is for students in their final year of study only.

Main Awards:

Sports Personality of the Year

Awarded to someone who is committed and enthusiastic to their sport or club and has shown they have made an important contribution to their club and united the club members by creating a friendly and welcoming environment.

Society Personality of the Year

Awarded to a member of a general interest club/society who have contributed to enhancing the reputation of club/society. The individual ensured members felt welcomed and comfortable and shown dedication to the club/society's activities.

Sports Club of the Year

The sports club has shown good sporting attitudes and fair play and made efforts to unite and support members throughout the year. Their achievements, effort and team work is above other sports clubs

Society of the Year

The general interest society/club who have run engaging and inclusive events which have positively impacted their members and the university community. The society have created or maintained a supportive and nurturing environment.

Elite Sportsperson of the Year

Given to student who plays at an elite level in their sport, showing significant progress, commitment and dedication.

Impactful Event Award

This is awarded to societies or sports clubs that have excelled at producing an engaging and impactful event. This event can be a collaborative event between 2 or more clubs or societies. The event has demonstrated originality, uniqueness, diversity and inclusion of its members and attendees.



Champions of Difference Award

An individual who has improved equality, diversity and inclusion in their club or wider student community. They have been dedicated to achieve a bias and discrimination free environment by raising awareness.

New Club of the Year

A new club or society that has had a very successful start, achieved club aims, organised with club administration and finances. Held multiple successful events (can be virtually or physical) and engaged members to show a good membership number.

Newcomer of the Year

This is an award for an individual who is new to the society or sports club that has shown great effort to positively contribute to their club/society. They have exceed expectations and gone above and beyond for the members of their club/society.

Biggest Leap Award

This is awarded to the club/society who has drastically improved from their activity last year. The club/society has shown improvement by increasing their membership, and participation by organising engaging events for their members.

Influential Impact Award

An individual who has gone above and beyond to compete or enable others to participate in SU Activities. They have worked behind the scenes to help and encourage other and had noticeable impact in club/society activities.

Varsity Team of the Year

A team or club that had a significant or impressive win in Varsity against Winchester. The team demonstrated fair play, good team cohesion, excellent sporting attitudes and represented University of Chichester as an institution and its ethos.
