ACTIVITIES REPRESENTATIVE (2 POSITIONS)

- Encourage and support the start-up of new student led groups to increase the breath of Activities available
- Promote and strengthen relationships with student led groups and collate club feedback and provide support were needed
- Embody and facilitate a sense of community and pride to enhance the overall student experience

WELFARE AND INCLUSION REPRESENTATIVE

- The Lead on campaigns related to welfare and inclusivity within SU Activities
- Work alongside UCSU Staff to ensure Equalities and Diversities training is up to date and relevant
- Engage with the student body to encourage student participation within SU Activities
- Champion a wide range of activities to ensure we our offer is relevant and appropriate for the wider student population
- Promote and strengthen relationships with student led groups to ensure they are aware of how they can raise concerns or request support
- Embody and facilitate a sense of community and pride to enhance the overall student experience

EVENTS REPRESENTATIVE

- To assist in the development and promotion of key UCSU and UCSU Activities events including but not limited to: SU awards, Summer Ball, Be a Better Ally
- Engage with the student body to encourage feedback and suggestions in relation to SU activities and events
- To support students with organising student led events and promoting these events within the wider University community
- Help co-ordinate and facilitate working groups to support specific events
- Embody and facilitate a sense of community and pride to enhance the overall student experience

RECREATIONAL SPORT REPRESENTATIVE

Students who fulfil the role must be activity engaged in sport related activities (although these do not have to be competitive i.e BUCS related clubs).

- To encourage and facilitate participation in social / recreational sporting events or activities to the wider student body
- Strengthen relationships with the Tudor Hale Centre for Sport to promote, support and collaborate on activities
- To engage with recreational sport related clubs, promote their activities and gather feedback to help enhance offer and increase engagement
- Help co-ordinate and facilitate working groups to support specific social sport events
- Embody and facilitate a sense of community and pride to enhance the overall student experience

COMPETITIVE SPORT REPRESENTATIVE

Students who fulfil the role must be actively engaged in sports related activities.

- Promote and encourage participation in competitive sport to provide the opportunity for students to represent the University of Chichester
- Strengthen relationships with competitive sports teams and gather feedback related to SU Sport
- Help coordinate and facilitate marketing surrounding fixtures and competitions
- Help recruit and co-ordinate volunteers to support and enhance the competitive sports programme (media, first aid support)
- Embody and facilitate a sense of community and pride to enhance the overall student experience
