## 2. Motion

## a. Disaffiliation from NUS

Intro: Looking to see what options there are for potentially saving money. NUS disaffiliation could be an option.

Question (Q): How will it save money?

Response (R): Pay affiliation fee, 3% of block grant. £300,000 grant, currently we have a £80-90k hole in the budget. Rationalising essentials.

## **DH Arrived**

We have bar supply deals and drinks deals from NUS, so would have to check out other suppliers for the bar and shop.

Q: Has another option for commercial services been sourced as yet?

R: When students don't come into the bar, shop, club and society memberships to bring in money, what are we to do?

Q: What are the Pro's and Con's?



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R: Pro's - Bars and shop get discount on product line.

Cons - pay £12,000 to affiliate, but still have to pay for conferences and training.

Useful to have the networking and contact, but Chichester is a different SU so we don't feel we get much from NUS.

Rob (South East Rep) contacted about visiting but we've had no further contact.

Comment (C): Tried to research how they use the affiliation fee

C: Confused by message of the Totum card and discounts

Q: If get stock for bar and shop would it cost more or less?

C: NUS Extra card, can get student discount with Unidays, Student Beans and/or student card, which are accepted rather than NUS extra. Better deals and discounts than NUS extra.

R: We do make money from NUS cards, but need to check that.

Q: How long would disaffiliation take?

R: Trustee Board would have to have input.

Q: Is there anyone within the SU whose role is based on affiliation with NUS?

R: Stella Smith (Cashier) issues NUS cards but not a significant part of her role, so wouldn't be a reduction in her hours.

LM: Need to ensure we inform students of what is happening and how funds will be used otherwise.

JG: Can campaign and promote on both campuses about the issues for and against.
